On 24 May 2012, His Holiness Patriarch Kirill of Moscow and All Russia and His Beatitude Archbishop Ieronymos of Athens and All Greece met with the Russian President Vladimir Putin at the Throne Hall of the Cathedral of Christ the Saviour.

The head of the Russian state greeted His Beatitude Archbishop Ieronymos, saying: I thank you for having timed your visit to this day, on which we celebrate the Name Day of our Patriarch and the Day of Slavic Literature and Culture. Addressing the head of the Russian state, His Beatitude Archbishop Ieronymos noted the importance and responsibility of his ministry. "Our people share the centuries-long history, and we need even more unity. It is very important to support one another in our time," he added.
