



His Holiness Patriarch Kirill celebrates memorial service on the third anniversary of the demise of Patriarch Alexy II

December 5th, 2011, marked the third anniversary of the demise of His Holiness Patriarch Alexy II of Moscow and All Russia.

His Holiness Patriarch Kirill of Moscow and All Russia celebrated memorial service at the tomb of the 15th Patriarch of Moscow at the Annunciation side-altar of the Moscow Cathedral of the Epiphany.

After the memorial service, His Holiness Patriarch Kirill addressed the worshippers and laid flowers at the tomb of Patriarch Alexy II. Also, a wreath was laid at the tomb on behalf of Patriarch Kirill.
