



Metropolitan Hilarion celebrates All-Night Vigil at the Russian Ecclesiastical Mission in Jerusalem

On 27 August 2011, the eve of the Dormition of the Mother of God, Metropolitan Hilarion of Volokolamsk, chairman of the Moscow Patriarchate's Department for External Church Relations (DECR), celebrated the All-Night Vigil service at the Trinity Cathedral of the Russian Ecclesiastical Mission in Jerusalem.

Concelebrating were archimandrite Isidor (Minayev), head of the Mission; archpriest Nikolai Balashov, DECR deputy chairman; hegumen Feofan (Lukianov), deputy head of the Mission; ordained staff members of the Mission, and Russian Orthodox priests on pilgrimage to the Holy Land.
