

International Conference on "Christian Charity in History, Historiography and Contemporary Culture" opens in Moscow

The International scholarly conference on "Christian Charity in History, Historiography and Contemporary Culture" opened at the Institute of World History of the Russian Academy of Sciences in Moscow on 16 June 2011.
