Anastasis/Artos&Norma Publishing House has published the book by Metropolitan Hilarion of Volokolamsk entitled “The Mystery of Faith” in Swedish.

The book was first published in 1996. It went through six editions in Russia, was published in English, French, German, Finnish, Japanese, Hungarian, Serbian, Polish, Ukrainian, Macedonian and Greek.

Bishop Kallistos of Diocleia wrote in his foreword to the first English edition, “*The Mystery of Faith* is written in a generous, holistic spirit. For the author there is no separation between theology and spirituality, between dogma and personal experience, between faith and prayer; all of them form together a single, undivided whole.
